September 23, 2024

As I write you today, I am still processing the beginning of our new preaching series, WHAT'S HAPPENING TO OUR FAITH?, alongside the events that took place in Five Points South on Saturday night, September 21st, in downtown Birmingham. The latest report, as I write you this week, is 4 folks fatally injured and 17 others sustaining injuries from the shooting. Just unbelievable my friends, unbelievable! And yet, in some sense of investigating what culture is experiencing in this current day, these events underscore that our faith is front and center...or at least should be! We must unapologetically be Salt and Light (Matthew 5:13-16) in our community and beyond.

Our new preaching series continues over the next three weeks with the following:
September 29 th The Message Hasn't Changed John 1:1-18
October 6 th Getting Back in the Game Joshua 24:1-15
October 13 th Revealing the Unknown God Acts 17:22-31

In my studies over the last weeks preparing for our current preaching series, one of the impactful quotes I've come across is by Rev. James Emery White, in his book, <u>Christianity for People Who Aren't Christians</u>, "God could have made us love him, but if he had, his relationship with us — and ours with him — would have been meaningless. As I've said before, God wants our relationship with him and with others to be real. So, he came to us."

I hope and pray that each of us can experience that magnitude of these words... "So, he came to us." Isaiah described God as the Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Prince of Peace, and White is reminding us that He chose to reveal Himself to us through His one and only Son, Jesus Christ. Witnesses (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John - among others) give us "eye-witness testimony" to God's love for you and me.

Let's all give some time to letting that sink in...God chose to reveal Himself to each of us...it seems core to our beliefs that we too would want to reveal Him to others! Especially those who don't know Him, especially those who aren't experiencing Him through Worship, Prayer, Study, Service, Giving and Fellowship. Who is God putting on your heart and life to reach out to and invite them into a personal relationship with Jesus?
