

March 24, 2025

Greetings in the Name of Jesus! As we prepare this week's newsletter, we are entering the 17-22 nd days of the Lenten Season. We will have journeyed halfway through Lent (20 th day) by Thursday, March 27 th . I continue to pray that each of us are experiencing a daily spiritual time of renewal as we walk with Jesus this Lenten

As we make our way to the half-way mark in the number of days, I am reminded of the prophet of Nehemiah. If you remember, Nehemiah was a cupbearer. A cupbearer was the person who served the king, King Artaxerxes at the time of Nehemiah, with the responsibility of ensuring that the king's wine was not poisoned. Many had regular access and influence of the king, and the cupbearer was a protector. Nehemiah, being a cupbearer, was also an Israelite who had heard that "The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned by fire."

Making a longer story shorter, Nehemiah, heartbroken at this news, desired to return to Judah and rebuild the wall. His desire was granted by the king, and as he and the Israelites began to rebuild the wall, opposition rose up to stop its rebuilding. The people grew worried and concerned...even delay began to take place in its rebuilding. At the half-way point of the building of the wall (day 26) Nehemiah gave a powerful reminder to the Israelites about their calling to serve God by facing the opposition to rebuild the wall with perseverance under the watchful eye and protection of God. Thepeople responded by completing the wall in 52 days.

We may find ourselves at day 20 of the Lenten Season needing a bit of perseverance...spiritual perseverance to continue in the calling to Observe a Holy Lenten Season. I hope that each of us is finding an abiding and growing relationship with Jesus as we embrace and participate in intentional acts of Worship, Prayer, Fasting, Study, Service, Giving and Fellowship. I pray that each of us is finding a constant filling of God's presence as we have sought to give something up/remove something from our life...that God might have a stronger presence in our daily living.

Please know that you are in my daily prayers as we continue the journey...
