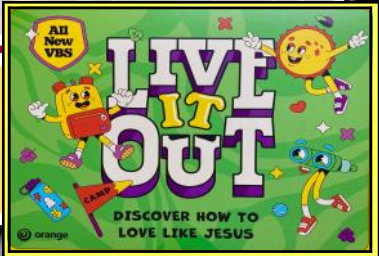
HUEYTOWN CITYFEST JUNE 14th
