Greetings Friends! I hope and pray that you are well this week! It was so good to be back with each of you for worship on Sunday, September 21, 2025. I want to thank Bro. John Simmons for filling in for me on September 14 th . He also had a couple of funerals during that time as well. Thank you, Bro. John and Nancy for all you do!

During my time away, the very tragic events took place in the assassination of Mr. Charlie Kirk. It was a shocking tragedy for all of America. The day of the event and the days after I sought to offer each of us a calling response to this event...be a difference maker and make a difference in how and where you live your life to be God's instrument of love.
